#### Why So Many Trees With Brown Leaves?

You may have noticed all the trees full of brown leaves throughout our neighborhood and along Moss Park Rd. This is not freeze damage. These trees are dead. They may look like oak trees but they are all Red Bay Trees. This is a sad story. The disease is called Laurel Wilt disease. It is a fungus spread by the Ambrosia beetle brought here in wood crates from Asia. This little 2mm long black beetle bores into a red bay tree and deposits the fungus which it then farms to feed its larvae. This kills the tree completely in a matter of a couple of months. There is no cure or preventive yet available.

Red bays are an important forest tree and source of food for many critters. All our swallowtail butterflies depend solely on red bays to reproduce. The forest service expects red bays to become extinct and therefore these butterflies will also likely be lost.

And it's not just red bays that are dying; it is anything in the laurel family. This includes sassafras, swamp bay and avocado. We may loose the multimillion dollar avocado industry in South Florida.

The tall loblolly bay or sweet bay trees that have the beautiful white flowers are not in the laurel family and are not affected. In future articles I would like to discuss invasive plants in our area.

Beer Braised Brisket

3 Slices thick-sliced bacon, diced

1 Flat-cut boneless beef brisket( about 3 pounds)

- 2 Large onions, sliced thin
- 1 bottle (12 ounces) dark beer
- 3 cups beef broth
- 2 Tablespoons chopped fresh parsley



- Preheat oven 321F. In large oven proof saucepan or Dutch oven, cook bacon over medium heat. Remove and set aside on paper towels to drain. Refrigerate when cool. Place brisket, fat side down, into hot bacon fat. Brown on all sides. Set aside.
- 2. Pour off all but 2 tablespoons of fat. Add onions; stir over medium-high heat until soft, about 3–4 minutes.
- 3. Add beer to saucepan, scraping bottom with wooden spoon to loosen browned bits. Add brisket and cover with beef broth. Bring to boil over high heat. Remove from heat, cover and bake in oven 3 1/ to 4 hours or until brisket is easily pulled apart 2 forks.
- 4. Remove brisket to cutting board and let rest 10 minutes. Trim off excess fat. Using slotted spoon, remove onion and set aside. Boil remaining liquid over heat and reduce to about 2 cups.
