





"This is a picture of Tara at the beach when she was three years old. i didn't realize that day now much I should have relished in that moment of her being so free."

My beautiful 17 year old daughter, Tara, has Friedreich's Ataxia (FA) which is a form of Muscular Dystrophy. It is a degenerative neuro-muscular disorder that affects 1 in 50,000 people in the United States and causes problems with coordination (ataxia) in arms and legs, scoliosis, fatigue and heart problems (cardiomyopathy). Last year I, along with many friends, participated in "Ride Ataxia" in Tampa, which is a cycling event to help raise awareness and research funds for FA. At the time of that event Tara was recently diagnosed and we were all still very devastated. When it was time to create our fundraising page I had no idea what to write

or how I would even get through writing it. Somehow I did and the event was a great success. Words will never be able to express our gratitude to everyone who was so generous with their help and donations. As a family we have come a long way since that ride but the ride isn't over yet. We will ride until there is a cure for my daughter and all of the other wonderful people that are affected by this disease.

This year, the "Ride Ataxia" event that we are participating in will be held in Orlando (Clermont). What makes this ride even more special is that Tara will be riding her Catrike bike that day. Tara also

wanted to write in her own words how FA has affected her and how grateful she is to everyone who can participate in the fundraising and awareness events for FA.

Savory Pumpkin Puffs

- All-purpose flour, for parchment
- 1 standard package (17.3 ounces) frozen puff pastry, thawed
- 1 1/2 teaspoons paprika
- 1/4 cup unsalted butter, melted
- 2 1/2 tablespoons Dijon mustard
- 1 1/2 cups finely grated Gruyere cheese
- 1 cup finely grated Parmesan cheese

Freshly ground pepper

Directions



1. Preheat oven to 375 degrees. Generously flour two pieces of parchment paper; on each, roll out an unfolded pastry sheet to form a 15-by-13-inch rectangle, about 1/16 inch thick. Refrigerate until firm, about 15 minutes. Meanwhile, stir the paprika into the melted butter.

2. Remove pastry from the refrigerator, and brush off excess flour. Spread a rectangle of pastry with mustard; sprinkle with both cheeses. Season with pepper. Lay a second pastry rectangle on top.

3. Place a sheet of parchment on top of the stacked pastry; using a rolling pin, roll until smooth and pastry layers are sealed together. Remove parchment, and brush top of pastry with butter mixture. Chill until firm, about 30 minutes.

4. With a pumpkin-shaped cookie cutter, cut into 18 to 24 shapes. Immediately place the shapes on a parchment-lined baking sheet. Using a sharp paring knife, score each shape four or five times to make pumpkin ridges. Bake until golden, 15 to 20 minutes. Transfer puffs to a wire rack; let cool slightly before serving.


POTATOES IN THE AIR

Have you noticed the air potato vine that is growing all over the Isle of Pines? It is considered the worst noxious invasive weed in Florida and certainly is the worst weed in our neighborhood. Some people may be growing it on purpose because the think the dark green heart shaped leaves are pretty but this vine is really bad stuff. I see it growing on fences and up trees all over the IOP. If you're not sure what it looks like just Google air potato on the internet.

Drive down Capri Rd. and you'll see it a lot of it growing up the trees in the vacant lots on the north side of the road. It can grow 8 inches a day and now that fall is coming it will be producing aerial tubers that look just like potatoes. Although this vine is a member of the yam family don't try to eat one; air potato tubers are toxic to people and pets. They grow by the hundreds, fall to the ground and sprout new plants. This is really bad stuff and you owe it to your neighbors to eliminate it from your property and from surrounding vacant lots.

Use glyphosate (Round Up). Pull the vines down from the trees as best possible and spray all of the green areas. Glyphosate only works on green growth and will not hurt trees when sprayed on the trunks. If you can't pull the vine down then cut it off low and spray what you can. Pick up any of the potatoes (tubers) and burn them or freeze them overnight to kill them. DO NOT PUT THEM WITH YARD TRASH THAT WILL BE COMPOSTED. You can bag them and put them in your regular trash. This weed is tough to get rid of; expect to spray multiple times over several years.
