November Board Meeting Minutes

Date: 11/1/2016 Start time: 7:10pm

Terry Gardner called the meeting to order.

October minutes were read and accepted and seconded with no opposition

Treasurer's report was not available.

Discussion of Old Business:

Wendi Rome and Maggie Odena did a fantastic job organizing the Halloween party and there was a great turnout. Mike Land is on track to chair the Christmas party this year with a budget of \$1100. More details for the event will come out in the December newsletter.

Ryan Hall will head up the community garage sale for Nov 4&5. Tammy will hang the banner into the neighborhood. The park may be used for people who do not have enough for sale to hold their own.

Door-to-Door speed hump survey is still in progress.

Basketball court expansion was discussed and recommended to have the job hired to complete. An additional \$1300 was approved to spend on completion taking the approved project budget total to \$2500. The motion to raise the project budget to \$2500 was presented and seconded. None apposed.

New Business:

Terry will contact the electrician regarding the flag pole not being lit. Tim has the flag properly stored until the light is fixed.

Plans for a boat parade and golf cart parade will continue with times and dates published in the December newsletter.

A budget was approved of \$700 for the membership drive with an additional \$300 for deposits. The date is still January 21 with the 2nd annual chili competition. It was motioned and seconded. Passed with no opposition.

Annual dues were discussed. If the dues should be raised and by how much. What would be done with the income. Upcoming requirements for maintenance were all discussed. The need for fundraising activities was discussed. Attendees were challenged to consider all these options for further discussions at the December meeting.

The need to have the septic tank pumped out was discussed and decided it was as cheap to clean as to inspect. The motion to clean was presented and seconded. 6 agreed and 2 apposed – the motion carried to have it cleaned.

Rachel Dance volunteered to help coordinate the dog park efforts.

Meeting adjourned at 8:00pm
