July Board Meeting Minutes

Board Members in Attendance: Jesse Dance, Terry Gardner, Shawn Krzanik, Fred Blankenbicker, Dana Atkin, Al Eastburn, Suzanne Arnold, Aspen Glashof, Wendi Rome, Buck Leahy, and Dave Singer (Alternate).

Absent: Ed Moon, Daniel Hart, Maggie Noblitt, Nikki Aikin (Alternate), Dominique Lombardo, Edgar Rodriguez, and Glenn Cuddihy

Guest: Mike Land, Becky Field, Randy Carlos, Robert & Christine Sheehan

OLD BUSINESS:

- Meeting called to order at 7:05 pm
- A motion was made, seconded, and carried to accept the previous months treasurer's report
- A motion was made, seconded, and carried to accept the previous month's minutes
- Efforts to get gutters installed on the pavilion have been finalized and will occur on the 7/22-7/26 week. Motion made, seconded, and carried for Jesse to close on contractor selection and execute within allocated \$400 budget for project.
- Terry has completed the locks replacement for the women's bathrooms.
- The chain link fence repair efforts are in the final stages and should be completed this month.
- A motion was made, seconded, and carried to allow both members and non-members to attend the park happy hour that occurs on the first Friday of every month starting in August for the remainder of 2019. This costs the association nothing and might assist in increasing our membership at the time of the drive or before.
- Efforts to improve the park signs are ongoing.
- The basketball court is getting a new backboard and rim. Buck reported that the backboard and rim are on order and should be arriving at the end of the month. Thanks to a generous donation from Pete for making this possible and Buck for doing all the research!
- Terry and Mike are putting together a Labor Day event full of entertainment, food, games, and raffles. The event and details will be advertised in the newsletter. They are looking for raffle donations and volunteers. If you are interested in contributing, please contact Terry (contact info is on page 2 of the newsletter).
- We are still trying to track down support clamps to replace six broken ones on the playground equipment. Buck action to coordinate with Edgar and Ed in an attempt to determine manufacturer or seller from whom we bought the equipment so that we can source the required replacement brackets. Action update at next board meeting. Dominique purchased 200 flags for the 4th of July and Keb volunteered to install them along LMJ road.

NEW BUSINESS:

- A motion was made, seconded and carried to allocate \$500 for replacement of playground swing chains, seats, and related hardware. Buck has the action for this project.
- Travis Little has said he would agree to be the IOP Park welder in exchange for a 2020 membership. After some discussion of the need for welding support for things such as gates, modification of the existing basketball backboard mount to accommodate the new backboard, and so on, a motion to approve this was made, seconded, and carried.
- In exchange for a 2020 membership, Mike Land has volunteered to be the weekly trash removal POC for normal park trash accumulation throughout the week (excluding Private Events) for the remainder of 2019 and all of 2020. Mike also agreed to ensure that one day prior to any private events, he would remove any trash on-site so that the park wouldn't have accumulated trash when people arrived. A motion to approve this was made, seconded, and carried.
- There was extended discussion about whether persons paying to stay in AirBnB rooms or houses belonging to IOP community association members should be entitled to have the same non-escorted access to the park as IOP members and the family members associated with their memberships. Eventually, a motion was made, seconded, and carried that:
- The discussion would be tabled at the meeting for the time being. The subject will be discussed and resolved at next month's meeting. Meanwhile:
 - Board members would be provided copies of the IOPPA charter and bylaws by email for re-familiarization of existing policy.
 - Jesse will research the implications for liability/insurance coverage for such people.
 - AirBnB customers are viewed as guests and need to be accompanied by the member during park utilization.

If you are member of the IOPPA then you may "reserve" the South Beach Park Pavilion. Go to www.isleofpines.org and look under the Community Calendar to see if the date is available. If it is, download the Private Function Application (Under Community Stuff). E-mail Edgar Rodriguez at Edgar@theremarkteam.com and let him know that you want to reserve the pavilion. Next, make arrangements to get the paperwork and your \$75 deposit check to Edgar. The pavilion isn't considered reserved until the check and paperwork have been received. Pick up the Private Function sign from Edgar on the day of your party. After the function, if all is in order then your check will be returned to you. REMEMBER: All garbage from the private function MUST be bagged and removed from the park. Park Rules are also located on the IOPPA website and should be reviewed before your function. Other members may still use the park and

facilities.




