



After the function if all is in order then your check will be returned to you. **REMEMBER:** All garbage MUST be bagged and removed from the pavilion. ## **OLD BUSINES**S:

Meeting called to order at 6:55 pm

A motion was made, seconded and carried to accept October's treasure report by Jesse Dance and Dana Atkin. No one opposed.

October's minutes will have to be accepted next month because there was no newsletter published for November. Jesse is coordinating a meeting in a few weeks with a new company to get a quote for various needed signage

throughout the park.

Daniel Hart continues to follow up with the fire marshal to get the large PVC pipe moved from along the side of the dock to underneath the dock. A request has been done to have this done so we are waiting for it to be rejected or accepted.

We are still investigating how to obtain replacement clamp parts for the playground. We may have to reinvent how to secure the clamps.

The board continues the efforts to come up with park improvement ideas. Someone has suggested to Jesse to make a beach volleyball area. Ideas, (expand existing pavilion, playground sunshades, restore the shuffleboard court, pavilion at the beach, boat ramp renovations).

The IOP POA gives a special Thanks to Mike Land for making all the signs and setting them up for the community garage sale.

A request was made by Jesse for people to gather some chopped up wood for the camp-night.

In the last meeting someone mentioned that a container should be placed for people to make sporting goods donations and a place to protect equipment from the elements.

Last week of October a few members removed debris left from the Boys Scouts Park clean up weekend campout and Halloween maze. Thanks to the people that helped.

The Shuffleboard area is cleared thanks to the boy scouts weekend. Jesse suggested that maybe it needs to be pressured washed and painted. Could also be used as a cornhole play area.

#### **New Business:**

A complaint was made about ants around the pavilion. Jesse talked to a pest control IOP resident. Pest control company may charge quarterly \$250. Maggie Noblett suggested other cheaper companies like maybe Massey \$390 a year. Other quotes to be made.

A discussion came out about security cameras at the park. An IOP resident came to the meeting to talk about it. After several incidents of vandalism at the park, actions have to take place. Comments have gone out via social media in the neighborhood about those vandalism actions.

John Nilsson offered to donate his home security system with camera to the park. Daniel Hart volunteered to work with John Nilsson to install the security cameras.

Buck made the motion to have John look into getting surveillance signs for the park, a hard drive, and helpers for camera installation. Ed Moon seconded.

For donating the security camera equipment, John Nilson was given a membership for the remainder of 2019.

Christmas POA event will be coming out soon. Help will be needed to get things going.

A motion was made to approve the \$1000 Christmas party budget by Suzanne Arnold and seconded by Dominique Lombardo.

Boat parade will be coming up soon. Volunteers will be needed to participate with the event.

January 25<sup>th</sup> 2020 was selected for the membership drive ... Al Eastburn made a motion, Dominique seconded. Time and budget will be discussed at the December meeting.

A suggestion was made by a board member to have the membership fee waived for the POA members that is donating the security cameras.

Meeting was called to end at 7:50 pm.

# **October Board Meeting Minutes**

#### **OLD BUSINESS:**

Meeting called to order at 7:08 pm

A motion was made and seconded to accept last month's treasure report by Al and Dana. No one opposed.

Supplies have been purchased and we have left over paint to finish the swing set. After the rain stops and the weather cools off, the swing set restoration effort will be completed.

The new basketball backboard and rim need to have an adapter bracket welded before it can be installed. We are working on a schedule with the community welder to complete the effort.

Jesse is coordinating with a new company to get signs made for various areas in the park.

Daniel Hart will continue to follow up with the fire marshal to get the large PVC pipe moved from along the side of the dock to underneath the dock.

Paddle fest event is scheduled for the weekend of 21st. Boat ramp will be accessible on Friday (20<sup>th</sup>) and Sunday (22<sup>nd</sup>) and closed on Saturday (21<sup>st</sup>).

Dana repaired the broken flag pole. Jesse will raise the flag this week.

We are still investigating how to obtain replacement parts for the playground.

The board has been tasked to come up with one major park improvement to focus on. Ideas, (expand existing pavilion, playground sunshades, restore the shuffle board court, pavilion at the beach, boat ramp renovations). Awaiting their ideas.

The swim area ropes still need reset. Jesse will ask Jessica from the Paddle fest to reset them for us after the paddle fest. If not, Shawn is willing to reset it with help.

Steps on the dock still need safety painted strips. The board will look for someone that currently has the yellow paint.

#### **New Business:**

Board sponsored IOP Camp night event November 8<sup>th</sup> and 9<sup>th</sup>. Set up 5-7 p.m. Friday night until 10 a.m. Saturday morning. No kid drop-offs. \$10 up to four people. Each person additional is \$5 each. Movie, hotdogs, s'mores, popcorn and breakfast. Fire pit set up on beach. RSVP reservation to Keb Basinet kebba-z73@gmail.com Tickets will be available through PayPal. More information will be available on our Facebook Events page. A budget of \$250 was motioned by Jesse and seconded by Dana. It passed with no opposition.

The park septic tank was recently pumped, and it was brought to our attention that the electric plug needs upgraded to a GFI outlet and placed in weatherproof housing. Also, the timers for the pavilion fans aren't working and need replaced. Luis the electrician quoted \$140 for supplies and labor to correct both items. Motioned by Dana seconded by Maggie. Passed with no opposition.

The Halloween party is scheduled for October 26<sup>th</sup>. This will be a Potluck event. There will be a costume contest for the kids, light decorating, music and water/juice beverages. Maggie will coordinate along with Melanie's help. However, more volunteers needed. A budget of \$300 was motioned by Jesse and seconded by Dana. It passed with no opposition.

Robin who cleans the park bathrooms shared the bathrooms were vandalized the weekend before the Labor Day party. This is not the first time but the worst so far. Jesse will elaborate and make a comment in President Notes in the Newsletter. Robin also shared that the bathroom is requiring more attention than twice a month. Moving into next year, we need to address the schedule and talk about increasing the budget.

Dana motioned to give Robin a performance award of \$50 for a thank you for taking care of the vandalism cleaning. The motion was seconded by Maggie. It passed with no opposition.

Glen requested a list of things needed done in the park for the Boy Scouts park clean up service project on Oct. 12<sup>th</sup>. Jesse suggested we compile a list from the Hot Wash list, email to Glen and then pick a few projects from there.

Meeting ended at 8:15 pm, motioned to adjourn by




