

Thanksgiving has passed us by. Hopefully everyone remained safe and healthy while enjoying the holiday with friends and family. Now we are heading into a busy month of shopping, social events, lights, cooler weather, and holiday festivities. Remember that some people are not as fortunate as others. If you can help another person out, please take the time or make the donation to do so.

Let's start off with a boat parade around LMJ December 11th starting around 7PM. If you live on the lake and don't want to go for a boat ride, please decorate your dock and come down to support the parade. Next, is the Christmas Dinner with a probable Santa sighting Sunday the 13th. The Christmas Dinner event goes from 5-9PM. Deep fried turkey will be the main staple with several additions. We will have an IOP membership drive/Board election/Chili cook-off January 23 from 4-8pm. During our November Board meeting the topic of late-night airboat traffic in the park was discussed. With the airboat group present at the meeting, we were able to solidify ground rules for the use of airboats in the park that align with our existing park rules. Airboats can be launched and retrieved at the west end of the park (on the grass) during daylight hours (dawn to dusk). During daylight loading and unloading operations, they will make a conscious effort to be expedient and operate as quiet as possible. All other times, they will be required to use the concrete boat ramp during launch and retrieval activities. To provide clarity to the

community and airboaters of the park rule's, park signage has been added stating: Airboat Ramp From Dawn to Dusk.

Last topic to bring to everyone's attention. With the weather cooling off and more people exercising outside, the backroads (North and South of Capri) are not a drag strip or racetrack for any type of vehicle (4-wheeler, dirt bike, side-by-side, motorcycle, car, or truck. The speed limit is 25mph everywhere in the IOP except for LMJ Rd., which is 35mph. Please-Take a deep breath, relax, think clearly, be responsible, and slow down.

IOP-Stay cool, safe, alert, healthy, friendly, small and slow down.






Non-Membership sign up/renewal requires admission. Chili tasting will be \$5 for adults and \$3 for children 5 years and up.
