- Ramp quote update:
 - Quote #1-Inspected the ramp with a diver. Has not returned/answered any requests for a quote.

 - Quote #3-Wanted to completely remove and replace the entire ramp and was way out of our budget (~\$150k).
 - Quote #4-Came in over \$100k
 - Quote #5-Awaiting assessment and quote
 - Quote #6- We patch it up ourselves and continue to save towards replacement
- The audit committee conducted the 2020 IOP finance audit with no findings. The board accepted the results of the audit committee.
- The budget committee will present the purposed 2021 budget at the next meeting.

New Business:


