- We were unsuccessful in finding cheaper insurance last month and had to renew the park insurance policy at \$5400 for the year, an \$800 increase from last year. We will shop around for a lower cost policy after hurricane season.
- Labor Day is coming up. We are still looking into making it a fundraiser event, but need a volunteer to organize and promote the event.
- Nikki Bazinet has volunteered to lead the Halloween event this year.
- We have received feedback regarding the park landscaping services. Jesse will
 meet with the company to address the feedback and work towards a path
 forward.
- Suzanne with a motion and Justin with a second to have a conversation with the current landscape company and review the contractual obligations. If the contractual obligations cannot be met, the IOP will switch services to another company.

Old Business:

- Start time: 7:05 pm.
- Board accepted treasure's report from July, Suzanne with a motion and TK with a second. No one opposed. Motion Passed.
- Board accepted the July minutes. Buck with a motion and Rick with a second. No one opposed. Motion Passed.
- Playground replacement clamps and brackets are here and ready to be installed.
- We have another quote for the dock ramp. We are coming up with some ideas on how to raise money to cover the expenses as we request other quotes.
- New gate locks have been replaced but we are still trying to get it to work in a way that the user can only get the key when the lock is secured.
- Water softener has been acting up. Service people came and checked it and now the water seems to be clear.

New business:

- The swim area ropes that connect to the dock are broken. Ed will make an assessment of the damage and work on the repairs.
- The builder of the playground equipment came out and assessed the condition of it. The overall condition is good but there are a few items that are showing wear. We are waiting on quotes for replacement parts and for engineered wood mulch.
- Park lawn maintenance issue is being reviewed. Current company has been cooperative and responsive to complaints.
- Our board welcomes Ryan Akos as an alternate member. TK with a motion and Buck with a second to approve Ryan as alternate board member.
- We are looking at the park insurance to verify that our coverage is up to our association needs.
- Halloween is approaching. Nickie Bazinet will lead the event. Budget committee has approved \$200.
- The board discussed multiple complaints brought to our attention with a newsletter ad. After a lengthy discussion, we will request changes to an image contained in the ad.
- We will work on the disclaimer that will explain more of the rules and steps to follow.
- Pavilion stage is broken and will arrange to get it fixed before Halloween.
- TK with a motion and Buck with a second to end the meeting at 8 pm.






